

Health & Safety Policy

Monitor the effectiveness of the company safety policy, revise as necessary and bring any changes made to the attention of all staff, contractors and visitors.

Seek the advice of and provide competent person(s) in all matters of health, safety and welfare.

Work together with our clients, for example Network Rail to meet their requirements and to improve standards of safety on site.

To ensure all employees and sub contractors comply with measures put in place by the company to ensure health and safety at work.

Arrange for adequate resources and funds to be available to meet the requirements of the policy.

The Operations Board of Directors shall review this policy annually or at any change of circumstances affecting the health and safety policy, i.e. changes in law, introduction of new processes, machinery or working environments.
