

Our performance in FY2020



Our annual report and results is out now and available for everyone to take a look at our performance over the last 12 months.

As we know, our turnover has been affected by the Covid-19 outbreak but thanks to your hard work and dedication over the year, we are in a strong position to bounce back.

Key financial highlights:

- £84.4m turnover
- £0.3m underlying operating loss
- £4.2m net funds

Raising the bar on highways project

The team working on the M4 Wichelstowe project has set the bar high for piles installed in a day.

The team, completing phase one of the project in August, installed six no. 1200mm rotary bored piles in one day after hitting some tricky obstacles.

But thanks to some quick thinking, first class fleet support and supply chain management, the team were able to complete the extra coring work required as well as the impressive piling rate.

Electrifying teamwork on major infrastructure project

Our Rail and Strata teams are working together to deliver the Midland Mainline Electrification Key Output 1a project between Kettering and Market Harborough.

The critical infrastructure improvement work in the East Midlands follows success on other sections of the project between Kettering and Bedford, with Strata providing crucial ground investigation work and the Rail team utilising our specialist on track rigs to provide access on site.

The work is set to continue until late 2020 and will enable the foundations for overhead line equipment on the new electrified railway line.



Connecting the North East

Our Vibro piling team has successfully supported a £70.8m upgrade for the North East's road network. The team installed 210no vibro stone columns which supported a Tensar reinforced soil block as well as a retaining wall on the restricted access site. The restricted access also meant that a special pile testing zone of just two by two metres had to be built.



Training centre up and running again

Our Training Centre is back up and running thanks to some excellent work from the team. With careful social distancing measures in place, the centre is offering its full suite of courses for clients once again. Training centre manager Mark Buxton said:

"It's picking up nicely. Since July there has been a significant increase in enquiries taken by the training centre. Notably more enquiries in CPCS, NPORS, NRSWA and SSP courses. We have been able to

keep the cost of our courses the same, even with reduced class sizes."

The works have been completed during weekend and weeknight possessions due to the scale of the equipment being used. Due to the working area, a custom piling platform was installed on a major A-road



creating an extremely delicate working environment.
