

RAIL TEAM DELIVERS EMERGENCY CATTLE CREEP WORKS

As part of an emergency framework contract with Amco, our Rail team has reacted quickly to improve safety on the Midland Mainline.

When a cattle creep in Leicestershire started to fail, the safety of humans and animals alike was put at significant risk.

Our team was able to mobilise quickly to install six No. H beams to strengthen the ballast walls of the bridge near Kibworth – making it safe for cattle to walk under the railway line again as well as making sure that the track bed remained intact.

The team was asked to carry out the emergency work by Amco to install the piles as

part of their LNE CP6 emergency works framework. The works were delivered safely and successfully with very short notice.

With around 120 rigs in our fleet, including specialist road-rail vehicles and other rail ground engineering plant, our teams are able to mobilise quickly for emergency work across the country.
