- Committed to the prevention of pollution.


We have analysed our activities' environmental aspects and evaluated their environmental impact. We recognise our key environmental impacts are in the areas of:

- Minimising waste through efficient use of materials and energy and by adopting the principles of reuse, reduce, recycle including plant, equipment and products used on tasks.

- Adopting an environmentally sound transport strategy
- Maintaining clear indicators to measure performance including waste, energy use and carbon emissions
